The **GSA Multiple Award Schedule**(MAS) Technology Program is designed to save time and money and support the federal government's strategy of modernizing and simplifying the purchasing process. State and local governments qualify for the MAS with the **GSA Cooperative Purchasing Program**.

## How to purchase technology through the GSA MAS program:

- **1. GSA Advantage:** State and local government entities may use <u>GSA Advantage</u>® after they <u>register</u> and obtain the necessary approvals.

Commercial products and services are available for purchase by state and local governments under 40 U.S.C. § 502(c). Entities that clearly fall under the definition of state and local government do NOT need to request an eligibility determination.
